Recent Developments

- There was a volunteer session held to plant daffodils.
- There have been a few issues with the compost bins. Gillian has now moved everything from the left-hand bin to the right-hand bin. Someone has dumped large branches in. There are Guardian newspaper wrappers mixed in. They are supposed to compost down but this only works in very hot composters. It was decided to put a padlock on the bins. We agreed that we would use one with a combination lock.
- Dave has discussed replacing the dying cherry tree with a plant expert. There is no issue with bacterial infection if we plant something in the same place but it is not the right position for a tree. Clare suggested a honey berry bush instead.
- The snowdrops are coming up.

Bridge Meadow

The Aldcliffe Yard Management Committee had planned to adopt the verge on Basin/Fox's Bridge with a view to Trianglers doing the maintenance. Nicola and Dave had a meeting with Anna who is the Coordinator for volunteers for the Canal and River Trust.

It became obvious during the discussion that the Trust are requiring a lot of bureaucracy. Health and Safety checks and risk assessments, planning documents, registers of people working, training courses and qualifications to use our own strimmer. The meeting was brought to a conclusion. Anna is going to get back to Nicola and Dave but if there are too many restrictions put in place it might be more trouble than it is worth.

Spring Fair

The date has implications for the type of plants that will be suitable for sale on our plant stall. Clare is going to plant some nasturtiums seeds. Gillian and Nicola have offered to look after some of the seedlings. Gillian has some strawberry and sedum plants.
